Training Practice

As a training practice you may from time to time consult with a postgraduate doctor or have a medical student present. For teaching purposes these consultations are sometimes video recorded. Permission from the patient will always be sought in these cases.

Postgraduate Training

It is a common misconception that postgraduates undertaking GP training are not yet qualified doctors. Anyone receiving GP training will have graduated as a medical doctor.

Undergraduate Training

To assist in the training of future doctors, our GPs will occasionally have students from Southampton University Medical School observing their clinics.

Patients will always be asked if they mind having a student in a consultation. Patients, however, may exercise their right to see the doctor alone.
